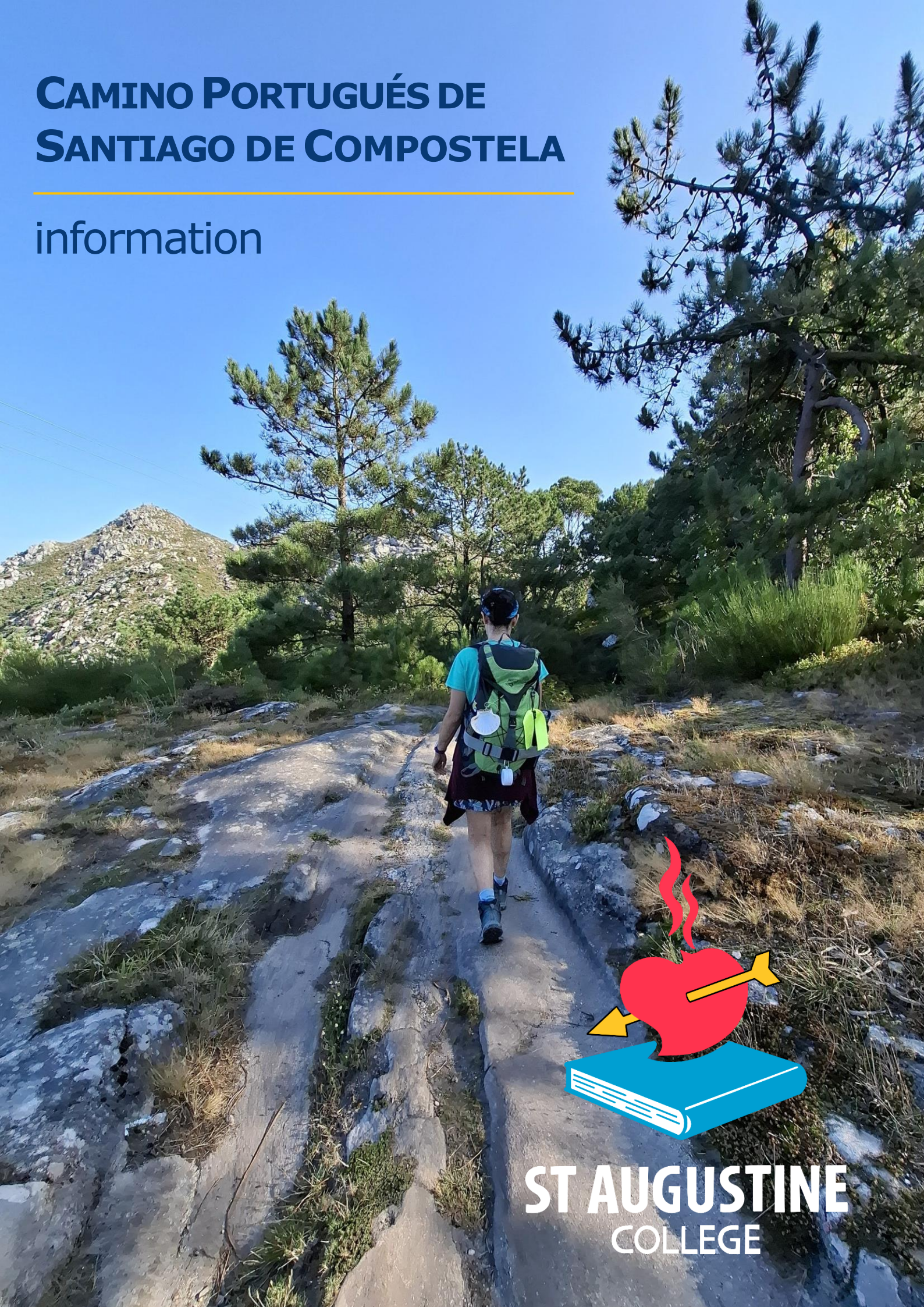

Introduction

The Camino Portugués is one of the oldest Caminos de Santiago on the Iberian peninsula and the second most frequented by hikers after the Camino Frances. From Lisbon to Santiago de Compostela it is over 600km and from Porto to Santiago de Compostela over 200km. We will be walking the last 120km of this beautiful Camino.

Flights | Duration | Accommodation

On 30th June: The group flies from Malta to Porto and travels by coach to Valença do Minho. **Flight: FR1509 18:15 – 20:35.**

On 7th July: The group returns to Malta from Porto. **FR1510 at 21:00 – 01:05(+1)**

Hotel accommodation will be in pensions, B&Bs in twin-sharing basis¹.

Daily Itinerary

The Camino is from Valença do Minho (Portugal) to Santiago de Compostela Spain). We start from Fortaleza do Valença do Minho and cross the bridge over the river Minho to Tui, in Galicia, Spain.

1st Jul: We walk from Valença do Minho, stopping to view the historic centre of Tui and continuing to O Porrino. Distance: < 22km | Elevation: + 82m – 113m.

2nd Jul: We walk from O Porrino to Arcade. Distance: < 27km | Elevation: + 275m – 282m.

3rd Jul: We walk from Arcade to Pontevedra. Distance: < 15km | Elevation: + 62m – 90m.

4th Jul: We walk from Pontevedra to Caldas del Rei. Distance: < 22km | Elevation: + 162m – 153m.

5th Jul: We walk from Caldas del Rei to Padron. Distance: < 20km | Elevation: + 138m – 157m.

6th Jul: We walk from Padron to Santiago de Compostela. Distance: < 24km | Elevation: + 312m – 66m.

¹ We can inquire regarding single supplement (and the extra charge for it) if there are people who prefer a single supplement.

Contribution per person

1. The contribution is € 955 per person and covers:
2. Twin-room sharing, ensuite, accommodation on bed and breakfast basis² for the whole duration of the Camino.³
3. Flights: Malta – Porto-Malta, Airport transfers from Porto Airport to the first accommodation and from Santiago de Compostela to Porto⁴.
4. Daily baggage transfers (**10kg** per person). This allows pilgrims to only carry their day-pack on the Camino and not the full week's requirements.
